
Above Ground Greywater Treatment Systems

Greywater Recycling

A typical household uses on average 135 to 155 litres of water a day with typical usage shown as



Recycling treats this waste water so over 60% can be reused for general cleaning, gardening, flushing toilets as well as use in the laundry thereby reducing overall consumption and saving money.
